The Angus H. MacLean award is presented yearly to a person who has made outstanding contributions to Unitarian Universalist religious education. It is awarded by the Lifespan Faith Development staff group of the Unitarian Universalist Association and the Alumni Association of the St. Lawrence University Theological School.

Universalist Angus H. MacLean, dean and professor of religious education at St. Lawrence University Theological School, was a pioneer in Unitarian Universalist religious education theory and a beloved teacher of ministerial students. It is appropriate that we recognize the inspiration and warmth that MacLean gave our faith as well as his great concern for the religious nurture of both children and adults.

A nominee for the award should be a UU who has:

- ❖ contributed significantly to the quality of religious education at the local level
- ❖ contributed significantly to the quality of religious education at the denominational level
- ❖ been innovative in the development of religious education resources, theory, and/or practices
- ❖ brought leadership and dignity to the profession of religious education.
