One Useful Tool

New Adult Curriculum now Online

A new program for Unitarian Universalist (UU) adults aims a UU lens on the moral choices, large and small, we face every day. The ten two-hour workshops in **What We Choose: Ethics for Unitarian Universalists**, by Rev. Amber Beland and Rev. Manish Mishra-Marzetti, lead participants to explore how we do, or could, make ethical choices grounded in our "deed over creed" faith. To what authority do we turn, when we reach a moral or ethical crossroads? Participants articulate their personal framework for ethical decision making, as they journey through a variety of frameworks from Kant's categorical imperative to one's own wisdom earned holding a particular social/political place in the dominant culture. Appropriate for older youth through adult.
