Keeping Up to Date in the Ministerial Search Cycle

If you are considering search or wanting to better understand the search process, the Transitions Office is creating a confidential email list to send out regular updates about the current search year. The emails will consist of information on deadlines, tips on the search process, ideas to think about, and updates on congregations in the search process as well any new developments. You do not have to be conducting an active search to be on this list. You will not be able to post on the list, though you can request to the Transitions Office that something be posted. This will include information on all types of ministry - settled, interim, developmental, contract, assistant, and community. Once the search year is concluded, a final email will be sent offering people the chance to re-enroll. The list will be open to ministers, UUA staff, ministerial candidates cleared for settlement, and ministerial settlement representatives. This list will be completely anonymous.
