Following a multi-year process involving thousands of Unitarian Universalists across the country, the Youth Ministry Working Group's report has been released. The Youth Ministry Working Group's report offers a comprehensive set of recommendations for youth ministry at all levels of our Association—from the local congregation to the national headquarters staff. The goal is to create a youth ministry that is spiritually deepening, faith developing, inclusive and anti-oppressive, a ministry that provides multiple pathways for youth involvement in congregational life.
